



## Access requirements for small OMNIBUSES -

### **PEOPLE MOVERS** (MA or MB category)

A minimum passenger seating capacity of six (6) and a maximum of eight (8), including where a seat is removed to fulfil access requirements.

### **VANS** (MD1, MD2 or MD3 category)

A minimum passenger seating capacity of nine (9) and maximum of fourteen (14).

### **PERSONNEL (TROOP) CARRIERS** (NA category)

***These access requirements for small omnibuses must be met in addition to the vehicle specifications that apply in each omnibus category.***

### **ACCESS REQUIREMENTS**

#### **For people movers and vans:**

- A seat (ie. an 'out board' seat) that requires folding to attain access or egress to any seating position, or otherwise precludes minimum access requirements, may be required to be permanently removed. *Note:* An 'out board' seat is a front or rear-facing seating position nearest the vehicle side wall where the seat cushion is within 200mm of this side wall.

#### **For vans:**

- A minimum aisle width of 300mm applies.

#### **For personnel (troop) carriers:**

- In the interest of safety, personnel carriers similarly configured to the Toyota Landcruiser may require modification to include an extra side door where rear passenger access is inadequate.

***Your vehicle may require modification to fulfil these access requirements. If you have any queries, please contact Passenger Services prior to presenting your vehicle for inspection at a DPI Inspections Centre.***
