



Multi Purpose Taxi (MPT) Cadetship

Are you interested in working with people with disabilities?

Passenger Services, Department of Transport, want to ensure there is always a pool of fully qualified, customer focused MPT drivers available to progress into the industry as opportunities arise.

If you are interested in working with people with disabilities and are currently working as a taxi driver in the Perth metropolitan area, you have the chance to obtain a MPT Cadetship from the Department.

Who can apply?

MPT Cadetships are open to all current licensed taxi drivers in the Perth Metropolitan area.

What is provided under the Cadetship program?

FREE training which includes instruction from an experienced MPT operator and classroom training.

FREE mentoring – once you qualify as an MPT Cadet you are entitled to special coaching from an MPT mentor AND free business training.

Please note that the Department does not provide direct employment as an MPT driver. MPT Cadets start out as shift/lease driver. Later you may apply for a plate and purchase a vehicle to operate in the MPT industry.

How to apply

Complete the application form, including the contact details of a character reference and post it to the address on the application form. Applications close 5.00pm Tuesday 8 September 2009.

You may be selected for an interview where the panel could ask about your skills, experience and reasons why you want to work with people with disabilities.
